Gallery Walk Requirements

General Instructions

- The Gallery Walk presentations will immediately follow the Speed Round presentations. The purpose of the Gallery Walk is to provide participants a chance to speak individually with communities and to learn together to identify promising program practices, emerging community practices, and common misconceptions and barriers to using federal funding to support these practices.
- Each community will have a mounted 22x28 inch poster with graphics and information that is displayed on a table. The community may also provide brochures, fact sheets, or other materials on the table.
- 1-2 team members will host the presentation while all other Summit participants circulate the room to view presentations and ask questions to the presenters.
- Each community will create one poster. We will have this printed and mounted for display at the Summit.
- We will be having a competition for best poster, so be creative!
- Submit poster design in **PDF format to alex@poppeassociates.com by October 2nd, 2014.**
- The Gallery Walk posters from each community may also be published following the summit.

Specific Instructions

- The Gallery Walk will give you a chance to expand on any points you believe did not receive enough attention during the speed round. For instance, you might decide to further explore your interesting anecdote with pictures and an extended description.
- The poster must contain the name of your community and contact information to learn more about your efforts. Include the names of key organizations involved in the effort.
- Make sure the information on the poster is detailed but easy to read.
- Include charts, graphs, pictures, and other graphics which you believe illustrate data trends supporting your community's methods of addressing homelessness through employment and training.
- Describe use of WIA and other federal funds to pay for employment services and programs that target homeless jobseekers.
- All photographs must have appropriate releases as they will be used in a public setting. It is the responsibility of the community to ensure appropriate permissions have been obtained.
