

Targeted Federal Homelessness Funding:

How the President's FY 2024 Budget Compares to Past Budgets



President Biden's budget targets nearly \$10.3 billion in federal funding for homelessness assistance programs. The budget represents an overall 6% increase from FY 2023 and an increase of 90% for DOJ's Transitional Housing Assistance Grants to Victims of Sexual Assault, 64% for HHS' Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness, and 23% for HHS' Health Care for the Homeless.

¹ Public Laws 116-26 (2019) and 117-2 (2021) appropriated supplemental funding in the amounts of \$30 million and \$110 million respectively to FEMA's Emergency Food and Shelter Program to provide assistance to migrants released from DHS custody, primarily along the southern border (amount excluded from table).

² The Mental Health PRNS is composed of the "Homelessness Prevention Programs" and "Homelessness" budget line items in SAMHSA's Mental Health Account.

³ The Substance Abuse PRNS is composed of the "Treatment Systems for Homeless" budget line item in SAMHSA's Substance Abuse Treatment Account.

⁴ HUD-VASH Vouchers have been appropriated since FY2008 and are renewed within the HUD Voucher account. This table does not report on total renewal funding for HUD-VASH or Tribal HUD-VASH - only new funding for incremental vouchers.
